## Monthly Survey for the Hotel Performance

January -September 2024

The Hellenic Chamber of Hotels (HCH) has commissioned the Research Institute for Tourism (RIT) to carry out a monthly survey for monitoring the basic hotel variables for 2024.

The survey is conducted monthly by sending a short electronic questionnaire to a representative sample of hotels, both in terms of hotel category and in terms of the region in which each hotel is located.

The variables under consideration are the following:

- The hotel operation period
- The Occupancy Rate
- The Average Rate of a double room

The research is carried out using the CAWI - Computer-Assisted Web Interviewing method, while during the processing of the questionnaires a triple weighting is applied in terms of the hotel class rating, of the region and of the hotel size.

The average occupancy rate of open hotels for September 2024 is estimated at 83,5%, compared to 79,3% for 2023. There is difference in the average occupancy rate between year-round and seasonally operating hotels. The average price for a double room for September 2024 is estimated at €155, and it appears to have increased compared to last year (€128).
